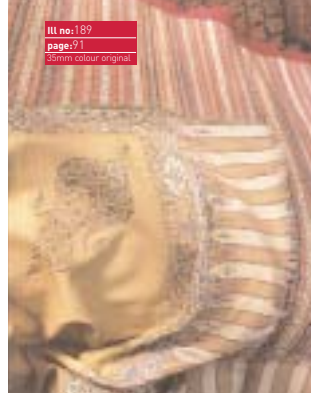

For jewelry designer Gabriella Kiss, working in a converted church, where the largest room can accommodate an 18-foot Christmas tree, can be somewhat overwhelming. But in every other respect it suits the family's lifestyle perfectly.

Aside from being ideal for gatherings and basketball, it works excellently as a space for displaying modern and primitive design, which Gabriella and her husband Chris Lehrecke have been collecting for more than twenty years. Chris himself has been designing and building furniture for most of that period, too, and the space is filled with his pieces and those they have collected.

The converted Baptist church, in a pleasant hamlet about twenty miles from the Hudson River, is home to the couple, their two sons, Jack and Augie, and their two cats and two dogs. They first heard about it through a friend in New York: 'She knew the previous owner from her childhood,' explains Chris. 'He was a classical musician and used it as his weekend home for twenty years, restoring it and doing much of the original conversion.'
