Sunbeam (pg159) is the home of Indian style guru, Jivi Sethi, and is located in the charming village of Assagao. Krishna, Jivi's man Friday, has always cooked for Jivi and friends and in 2010 opened Goa's first Private Dining experience. The evening begins with drinks on the terrace in the lush tropical garden and then dinner is served on the upper terrace where a magical setting is created with candles, flowers and lavish decorations. The menu rotates daily featuring Lebanese, French, Italian, Indian, Burmese and Thai cuisine for under ₹1000 per person. Spirits, Indian and international wines are available. *A Love Goa highlight. Be warned, an evening at Sunbeam will fuel your dream of moving to Goa.*

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Sunbeam is the Goan home of the exuberant, eclectic and exciting Jivi Sethi. Designer and diva, socialite and social activist, Jivi has created a splendid Goan home and is a gracious host. When he is travelling (most of the time), his long-term man Friday, Krishna, is at the helm looking after guests in impeccable fashion. Located in my favourite village, Assagao, you know you have reached Sunbeam when you see brightly coloured Balinese dancing flags fluttering in the breeze. Stone *Kalinga* lions flank the entrance to the main house, which is set around a central courtyard. As well as the relaxed living space, complete with Chinese opium bed, Sunbeam has a grand formal living and dining room. Two luxurious guest bedrooms overlook this area and a third bedroom is on the next level with a splendid garden terrace. A highlight of this property is the flamboyant swimming pool with a huge granite *lingam* at one end and a superb *Nandi* bull sculpture at the other.

The property ranges in price from ₹80,000 per week low season to ₹100,000 high season and more over the festive period. If the house is not fully booked, you can book per room, at a cost of ₹6,000 monsoon and ₹9,000 the high season, excluding the festive period.

Jivi and Krishna have introduced *private dining* here at Sunbeam (pg 28).
